# Summer 2025 Experience for International Students: Intensive English Program for Global Citizens

Recognizing that every person is an important member of a local and international community, the Intensive English Program for Global Citizens is designed for college-age students seeking to improve their English communication skills while developing their awareness and understanding of the wider world and their place in it.

The Global Citizens Summer Camp offers students the opportunity to:

- improve speaking and listening skills to participate effectively in oral presentations and group discussions
- develop academic writing, vocabulary-learning strategies, and research skills
- build critical reading skills while examining on global issues
- collaborate with peers in a supportive learning environment under the guidance of knowledgeable and caring language instructors
- engage in conversation clubs on issues that relate to current events, intercultural communication and diversity
- create a portfolio to showcase language growth and confidence.

# **CURRICULUM**

The key components of the 3-week program are:

- > 50 total hours of classroom instruction
- > 2 hrs/week of the language partners program
- > 2 hrs/week of conversation club

#### APPLICATION DEADLINE: Friday, May 16, 2025.

Price includes tuition, medical insurance, airport transfer, on-campus accommodations and meals (3 meals a day), orientation and concluding events, course materials and social activities. Airfare and visa fees not included. Participants are responsible for obtaining their visa, including the application process and related fees. Participants may come on the B-2 visitor visa or ESTA visa waiver if eligible.

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Participants must have completed high school and have at a minimum a beginner level of English. Students may submit an English language proficiency test (i.e., the TOEFL, IELTS or Duolingo) taken within the last two years. Otherwise, classroom placement tests will be conducted on the first day of the program.
