

# **3+1 UNIVERSITY PARTNERSHIP WITH SNHU**

## **DEGREE OPTIONS:**

BBA (Bachelor of Business Administration) BALA (Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Arts)

### **Benefits of the 3+1 Program**

- 90 pre-approved transfer credits (for partner universities only)
- Students can complete their bachelor's degree in just one year (30-31 credits), given a certain level of English proficiency
- BBA graduates can continue at SNHU to earn an MS or MBA in one more year
- BALA graduates can continue at SNHU to earn an MS in one year or an MBA in 18+ months
- Scholarship options are offered through SNHU

#### **REQUIREMENTS**



90 credits from approved university (for BBA: 30 of the 90 credits from business courses)





\* BBA applicants with a GPA between 2.5 and 3.0 may be considered on a case-by-case basis.

\*\* TOEFL score of 79 or 6.5 IELTS will enable direct entry to the BBA or BALA program. Students with a TOEFL score between 71-78 or 6.0 IELTS (with no subscore below 5.5) will take Fundamentals of Writing for International Students. Students with a TOEFL score between 61-70 or 6.0 IELTS (with lower subscores) will take Undergraduate Language Studies. Lower scores will require enrollment in our ESL program. #### How Partnering with SNHU works

- **3.** Provide your grading scale, credit system, and proof of accreditation.
