What is the Science Communication Poster?

- It is a visual tool that turns complex academic research into an easy-to-understand format for the general public.
- **The Core Rule:** Participants must create this poster based entirely on the conference paper they submitted. It serves as a direct visual summary of their work.
- **Digital Storytelling:** Instead of physical boards, these posters are designed for social media to quickly reach a much wider audience online.



Why is it Essential?

- **Massive Online Visibility:** It pushes research beyond campus walls. Posting on social media (#WeAreStudent) brings massive digital exposure to the event and its sponsors.
- **Builds Future Leaders:** It trains students to confidently communicate their complex ideas to anyone, which is a vital skill for their future careers.
- **Connects with Youth Culture:** It updates traditional academic events to match how today's students actually communicate and consume information online.
